When making your son's travel arrangements, please be sure to carefully review and adhere to the precise times listed above. This is critical both for your son - to settle into his room, routine, and get a good night's sleep before beginning seder, as well for his roommates, and the atmosphere in the dormitory and yeshiva. Likewise for his departure, it is critical for him to finish the zman properly. Hanhala will therefore be very careful to safeguard this precise timeframe. Any change - even the seemingly minor - (including trips to happy occasions, etc.) requires approval from Hanhala *before* purchasing the ticket. We are aware that it is sometimes more convenient to organize travel at other times than the times set by Hanhala (cheaper airfare, the possibility of joining someone with travel etc.), but this is an opportunity to show and instill the importance of keeping seder, consideration for others, etc.
